AFTER SCHOOL ART PROGRAM

The Class:

This class is open to children in grades 3, 4, and 5 at Quispamsis Elementary School. Students will learn how to draw and paint a wide variety of subjects including, people, animals, vehicles, buildings, landscapes and more! For example, the students will learn how to give their characters emotions, how to create movement, how to create perspective, and tips for colouring. They will learn to draw in a cartoon style as well as more realistic drawing. Students will work with a variety of mediums including real artist's watercolour. Jennifer has a step by step project planned for each class that is easy to follow, fun and creates confidence in the children's abilities. Each session is different allowing students to return each year.



All supplies will be provided and are included in the cost of the course. Each student will receive a hard cover sketchbook on the first day of class. Students will be asked to bring this sketchbook with them every week. Classes run for **10 weeks** on **Thursdays** beginning **Thursday March 11th** through to **May 20th**. Classes are right after school until **4:15pm**. The fee is \$160 +tax per child. Family and returning student discounts are available. Class maximum is 25 so early registration is encouraged.
